DRAFT TRIALS

Friday, December 5th

Location: Bob & Dawn Fralick's
1980 State RTE 56 NW - London OH 43140

Test Hours begin at 8 AM each day and will continue until all teams have competed. Lunch will be offered – as decided by the judges. All judging will be outdoors. There will be two trials running consecutively – entrants are only allowed one entry per team and will be automatically assigned a trial with no preference allowed as to #1 or #2. Equipment check and course walk through will occur simultaneously for both trials – so, all entrants no matter which trial need to plan to be harnessed and hitched by 8 am.

Entries close at 5:00 PM, Wednesday, November 19th 2025, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the GSMDCA Draft Test regulations. The entry fee is \$45 for CRSC members - \$55 for non-members per single dog or brace.

Draft Trial Entry Information

Definitions: The term dog applies to dogs of both sexes. The term team means a handler and his/her dog. All terms and instructions and regulations that refer to a single dog also apply to a pair of dogs working together unless otherwise noted.

Important Details:

1. Entered dogs must be 18 months or older on the day of the Draft Test (date of birth on or before 06/05/2024).
2. Bitches in season are permitted to compete (see rules and regulations for details).
3. The Basic Control Exercise shall be waived for dogs that have earned an AKC Companion Dog (CD) title **IF** a copy of the CD title certificate is sent with the entry form. In the event the CD requirements were met, but the title certificate has not yet been received, the entrant may so state on the form and in a separate letter attached to the entry. If the dog passes the Draft Test, the NDD or DD title and certificate will be withheld until after the Draft Work Committee (DWC) Chairman receives a copy of the CD title certificate.
4. Handlers must provide the draft rig and weight for the freight haul. Any of the following draft rigs may be used: cart, wagon, sled, toboggan, or travois. Each of these must be equipped so that the draft rig cannot run up on the dog when hauling downhill.
5. The handler selects and provides appropriate freight load for the apparatus and the dog.
6. Entrants are responsible for obtaining the GSMDCA Draft Test Regulations and being familiar with them. The GSMDCA Draft Test Rules and Regulations have been revised, dated 11/1/23. Please insure that you have familiarized yourself with the new regulations.

Entry is limited to fourteen (14) teams total across both trials, whether entered in Novice Draft, Open Draft or Team Draft. If more than 14 entries are received, a random drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing time. Although it is the policy of the GSMDCA to invite and encourage any dog to enter a GSMDCA Draft Test, GSMDs will be given preference over other breeds. All entrants will be notified by e-mail of their entry status. Alternates will also be drawn and may compete in the absence of regular entries.

PRIZES

All participants will receive a ring prize and each dog with a passing performance will receive a trophy.

The Test Site

The maneuver course will be held in a fenced field on-site at the Fralick farm.

The Freight Haul course consists of a 1 mile trek primarily along cleared paths through fields and woods. There are at least 3 different surfaces (grass, gravel, and dirt) and a gradual down/upslope where the trail moves around the pond.

Two weight pull competitions under GSMDCA rules. They will take place under cover outside – they will be on a wheeled cart on carpet over concrete. Annette LaPlante & Kim Woollard will be our judges. The track is under cover – but, the pull will take place outside in the weather with no indoor place to crate or stay. So, please be aware that this is a December pull in Ohio and the weather will likely be cold. Make sure to plan and dress accordingly! Pre-entry only – no day of pull entries accepted – entries must be received by Wednesday, November 19th 2025.

The fees to enter your dog(s) each day in the weight pull competitions are as follows:

- \$25/dog per pull for CRSC members - \$30/dog per pull for non-members
- \$20/dog per pull for the veteran class

Trophies will be awarded to the dog(s) who achieve:

- Most Weight Pulled & Most Weight Pulled Per Pound
- Most Weight Pulled Veteran & Most Weight Pulled Per Pound Veteran

Dogs pulling 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place in their respective weight classes will receive a ribbon and prize. Weight classes are as follows:

- Under 90 pounds
- 90 to 109 pounds
- 110 to 129 pounds
- 130 and over pounds
- Veterans
