The site includes a barn for the weight pull and large open fields, woods, and trails for the draft trial, freight haul, and Sunday pack hike as well as for leisurely strolling and enjoyment of this beautiful property. There will be a large enclosed tent for meals.

Please help us to know in advance who is coming to the SwissAthlon by submitting an 'Events Summary & Sign-Up' page and a General Liabilities Release Agreement for each attendee, including people who are accompanying a dog handler or people who are just coming to visit. All of the working events require pre-entry this year. We look forward to seeing you in October!

LODGING

Dawn and Bob Fralick are our hosts for the SwissAthlon at their beautiful farm. To best enjoy all the events and experiences of the SwissAthlon, you are invited to set up a tent or RV onsite. To minimize the burden on our hosts and the disruption to their dogs, no one will be lodging in the Fralick's home. Guests staying onsite will have access to shower facilities, found in the heated garage. You will need to supply your own towels and toiletries.

New this year: As electrical hook-ups are very limited, we will assign the electrical hook-ups in advance. There are only one 50 amp and three 30 amp electrical hookups in the RV barn plus three 120 volt hook-ups in the tractor barn. Please note that the configuration requires an extremely long cord to access the power. The priority will be given to people with entries for Friday's working events, then requests will be filled in the order they are received. Please indicate on the 'Events Summary & Sign-Up' sheet what electrical connections could work for your set up. You will be notified if you are selected for one of the connections.

We are asking a lodging fee of \$20.00 per adult for the weekend, plus an additional \$20 if you receive an electrical hook up. These funds go to the CRSC to help cover the cost of tent rental, etc. for the event. We do require pre-registration for staying on-site – please indicate on the 'Events Summary & Sign-Up' page and make sure to submit by the registration deadline.

You can set-up starting at 3 p.m. on Thursday, October 5th. Please plan to pull in no later than 8:00pm on your day of arrival.

For those of you who do not want to camp, we recommend hotels at exit 91 (Hilliard-Rome Road) from I-70 in Hilliard, at the outskirts of Columbus. Here you will find a large selection of hotels from most of the major chains. Unfortunately, one of our visitors experienced a car break-in when parked at a hotel in the area, so please make sure to secure your valuables and be aware what is visible in the vehicle.

Weather

The events will go forward, rain or shine. We chose this time of year for our SwissAthlon weekend because, characteristically, the weather is sunny with mild temperatures, highs in the upper 60's to lower 70's. We hope that fair skies prevail for this very special event. Please be advised that in the years we have been hosting this event, we have experienced freezing temperatures through summer-like heat. Please tune into the weather and dress accordingly. There can be a high tick population at this time of year, so please prepare for that as well.

PACK HIKES

You can sign up for 8 mile back-to-back hikes (Saturday & Sunday) and earn two legs toward the pack dog title for completion. Alternatively, you can enter a 10 mile hike on Sunday only to earn a single pack dog title at the conclusion. Only one dog per handler is allowed.

No weight certificate needed – we will take dog weights and pack weights the mornings of the hikes.

Make sure to have adequate flea & tick protection because this is a bad time of year for ticks! All entrants will receive a participatory prize.

Course Descriptions:

Saturday, October 7th – Prairie Oaks Metro Park Hike

Hikers will meet up at the Fralick home garage at 8:00am for weigh in then entrants will drive to the Prairie Oaks Metro Park (about a 15 minute trip). There will be an 8 mile hike weaving through the fields, woods, and around the ponds at the Prairie Oaks Metro Park. Trails are mostly dirt and grass with some gravel. (no extension to 10 miles is available today).

Sunday, October 8th – Fralick Farm Hike

This hike will explore the Fralick farm after weighing in at 8:00am Sunday. There will be an 8 mile hike touring through the 100+ acre property for all those hikers completing their second hike, with an additional 2 mile leg required for hikers who are doing just this one hike. There will be chances for the dogs to jump in a pond to cool off and at least half the hike will take place in the shade.

Administrative Details:

The Pack Dog Hikes will be conducted per the GSMDCA Pack Dog Rules. All GSMD's over 18 month the day of the hike are eligible for Working Pack Dog Titles. Non-Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs are eligible to participate in GSMDCA pack dog hikes. Bitches in season are permitted.

First and foremost, hikes are to be conducted with the safety and well-being of the canine and human participants in mind. The Hike Coordinator is authorized to make any necessary decisions to protect the health and safety of the dogs and handlers.

Entry and Fees:

Pre-entry is required.

Entry fees for the pack dog hikes are \$30.00 per dog if entered both days -OR- \$20.00 per dog for a Sunday only. To enter the pack dog hikes, please complete a "[Working Pack Hike Event Handler Entry Form](#)" plus the "Consolidated Entry Form" for each dog along with your "Events Summary and Sign Up Page".

If you just want to enjoy a stroll, without entering to qualify for titling legs, feel free to join the group at the time of weigh in and walk the full or partial route. An "Events Summary and Sign Up Page" will still need to be completed for your presence at the event.

WEIGHT PULLS

Friday, October 6th & Saturday, October 7th

Two weight pull competitions under GSMDCA rules are featured during the SwissAthlon weekend. The format is wheels on carpet over cement. The event will take place under an overhang along the Fralick's wooden barn. We will have extra weight pull harnesses available for those who do not yet own one.

The weight pull will be held on Friday afternoon following draft trial and the membership meeting. The Saturday afternoon weight pull will occur after the draft trial, pack hike, and conformation fun match. Entrants must weigh in within 30 mins of the announcement of the start of the event.

Please note: **Pre-entry is required this year***. Complete your entries using the SwissAthlon "Consolidated Entry Form". The entry fee is \$25.00/dog each day.

Denise Mitterando will be our judge.

Prizes will be awarded to the dogs who achieve

- Most Weight Pulled
- Most Weight Pulled Per Body Pound
- Veteran class (age 7 or older): Most Weight Pulled
- Veteran class (age 7 or older): Most Weight Pulled Per Body Pound

Weight classes are as follows:

- Under 90 pounds
- 90 to 109 pounds
- 110 to 129 pounds
- 130 and over pounds

Dogs pulling 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place in their respective weight classes will receive a ribbon.

Dogs NOT eligible to participate: 1) dogs that are aggressive to humans, 2) bitches in heat, in advanced pregnancy (day 40 and beyond) or lactating, 3) dogs that are lame, have open sores, an obvious medical condition, 4) any other situation that the judge deems the dog not fit to pull.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Definitions: The term dog applies to dogs of both sexes. The term team means a handler and his/her dog. All terms and instructions and regulations that refer to a single dog also apply to a pair of dogs working together unless otherwise noted.

Important Details:

1. Entered dogs must be 18 months or older on the day of the Draft Test.
2. Entry is limited to 15 teams total, regardless of class entered. If more than 15 entries are received, a random drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing time. Alternates will also be drawn and may compete in the absence of regular entries. If there are fewer than 3 entries, the test will not be held. All entrants will be notified by e-mail of their entry status no later than five days prior to the test date.
3. Non Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs are welcome to enter this test, although GSMDs will be given preference over other breeds in a situation where the test maximum entry is met.
4. Bitches in season will not be permitted to compete at this test. Draft test entry fees shall be refunded upon receipt of a veterinary certificate stating an entered bitch is in season at the time of the Draft Test.
5. The Basic Control Exercise shall be waived for dogs that have earned a CD title **IF** a copy of the CD title certificate is sent with the entry form. For Brace Class entries, both dogs must have earned their CDs in order to waive Basic Control.
6. Handlers must provide the draft rig and weight for the freight haul. Any of the following draft rigs may be used: cart, wagon, sled, toboggan, or travois. Each of these must be equipped so that the draft rig cannot run up on the dog when hauling downhill.
7. Entrants are responsible for obtaining the current GSMDCA Draft Test Regulations and being familiar with them. The rules are available on the GSMDCA website under Working Activities then select Drafting.

Entries close at the Entry Coordinators on Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023 at 5:00 PM.

All entrants will receive a ring prize, and each dog with a passing performance will receive a qualifiers gift.

The Test Site

The maneuver course will be held in a fenced field on-site at the Fralick farm. The Freight Haul course consists of a 1 mile trek primarily along cleared paths through fields and woods. There are at least 3 different surfaces (grass, gravel, and dirt) and a gradual down/upslope where the trail moves around the pond.
