Meet up Locations on Montour Trail:

Day 1: **Montour Trail Parking, Moon Twp, PA 15108** at Montour Coketown Rd parking lot

Day 2: **Montour Trail Parking, Oakdale, PA 15071** at Cliff Mine Rd parking lot

Type in the addresses highlighted above to take you to the parking lot for both areas of the Montour Trail we will be starting from. There are port-a-potties available at the trailhead and at certain areas along the trail each day. Both days will be out and back hikes.

The fees to enter your dog(s) each day in the pack hikes are as follows:

- \$15/dog for both hikes for CRSC members and \$20/dog for both hikes for non-members
- **Entry forms must be received by February 17th**. Mail completed entry forms to Heather Kyslinger – 410 White Pine Lane, Baden, PA 15005. Make checks payable to 'CRSC'.
- Weigh-in of packs each day will start at 8:30 a.m. **A scale will be provided on site to weigh dogs and their packs.** Or you can choose to bring a veterinarian's certificate of the dog's weight must be provided. The weight may be taken up to 7 days prior to the hike. Weights may be noted on stationery, business cards, invoices, receipts or other documentation that demonstrates the veterinarian's certification via signature.
- Hikers will head out at 9 a.m. from the parking lot.
- **We welcome anyone to come out with or without their dog for fun or practice!**

These hikes are planned as back-to-back hikes meaning you will need to hike 8 miles each day & must complete both day's hikes to earn two legs towards a title.

Some COVID-19 precautions will still be taken for pack hikes

- The following individuals will not be permitted to attend the pack hike:
 - An individual who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms,
 - An individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last 7 days,
 - An individual who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks (exception, healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties)
- Participants must assume responsibility for themselves and bring all proper PPE & hygiene equipment with them including hand sanitizer if they are concerned about contracting COVID during the pack hike. Participants are also required to dispose of any and all trash or used PPE in proper trash receptacles around the park.
- If you cannot come due to personal health status, you must let us know by 8 am the day of the event if you will not be coming due to COVID complications (personal or state) for a refund to apply.

AGREEMENT: I agree that I am solely responsible for the actions of myself and the dog ("the dog") that accompanies me in relationship to this entry. I agree that I am attending the event entirely at my own risk, including the risk of Covid-19 or other communicable diseases, and take full responsibility for my own health and safety. In consideration of the acceptance of my entry and the opportunity to participate in this event, I agree to HOLD HARMLESS and INDEMNIFY the following listed parties from any claim for loss, damage or injury alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly by my actions or by the actions of the dog in relationship to this event: the Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America (GSMDCA) and the event-giving club (The Crooked River Swissy Club, a limited liability corporation) or group of individuals, their members, officers, and agents; the owner and/or lessor of the premises; any provider of services at this event; any employees or volunteers of the parties listed here, and any judge at this event. I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I agree to be responsible for any loss and expense (including legal fees) incurred by any of the listed parties based on claims related in any way to my participation or the actions of the dog in relationship to this event, whether the claims are made by third parties or by myself. Additionally, I agree to assume the sole responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to myself or to the dog in relationship to this event. I agree to RELEASE, INDEMNIFY and promise not to sue the parties listed above for any such loss, damage or injury to myself or the dog, regardless of the cause, and whether or not the loss, damage or injury may have been caused by the negligence of the listed parties. I AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE GSMDCA BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE GSMDCA CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES. I understand that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I agree to abide by rules and regulations of the Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America (GSMDCA) in effect at the time of these GSMDCA working events and other events and by any additional rules appearing in the premium list for these events. I certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement. I agree to conduct myself in accordance with all such Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accordance with them.
